







Eurasian Collared Dove Identification Tips


Eurasian Collared Dove : Chalcophaps indica: Widespread resident in India (Except Kerala)



Laughing Dove: Stigmatopelia senegalensis cambayensis: Widespread resident in India (Except Himalayas & North East India)






