



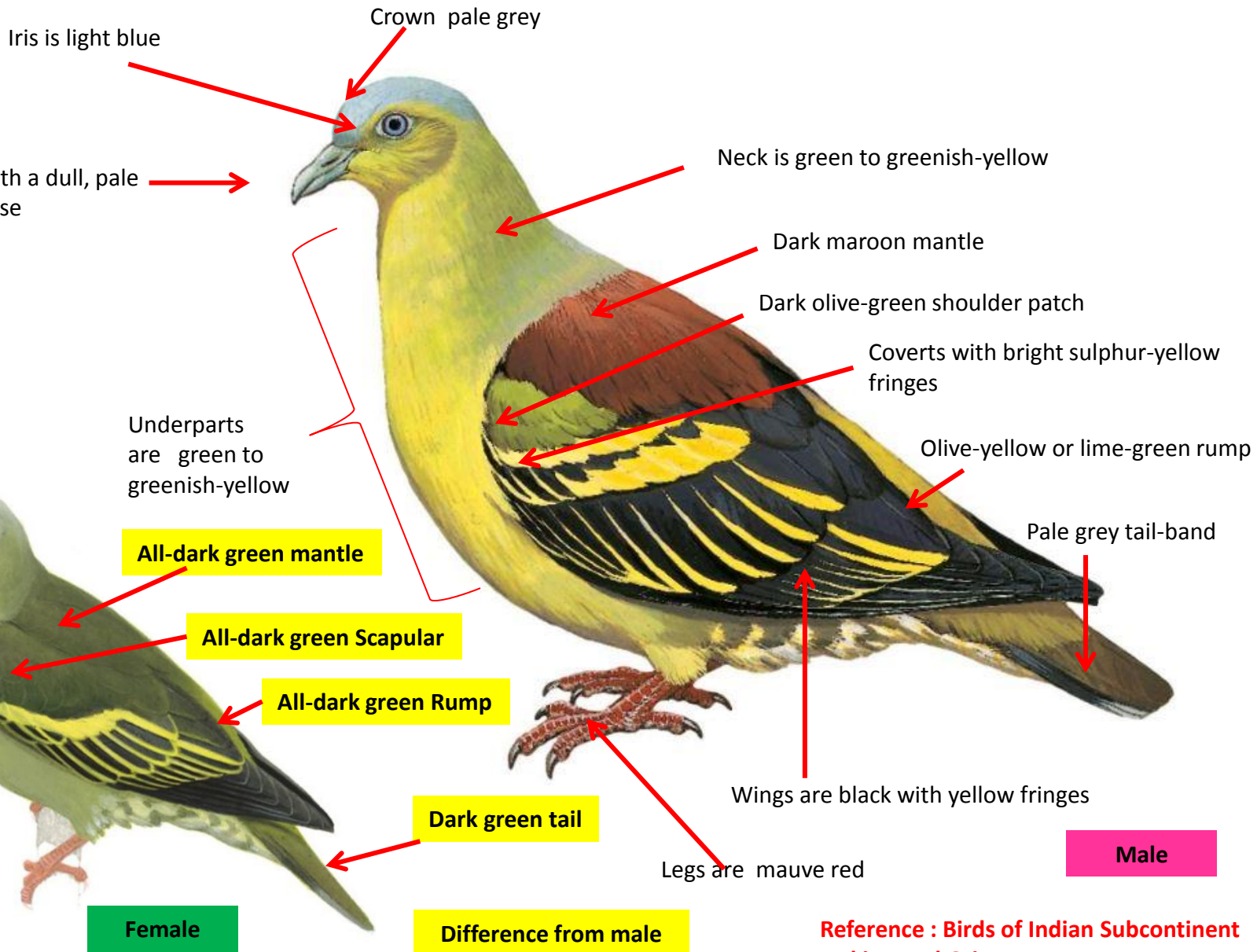

Andaman Green Pigeon : *Treron pompadora chloropterus*: Resident of Andaman & Nicobar in India

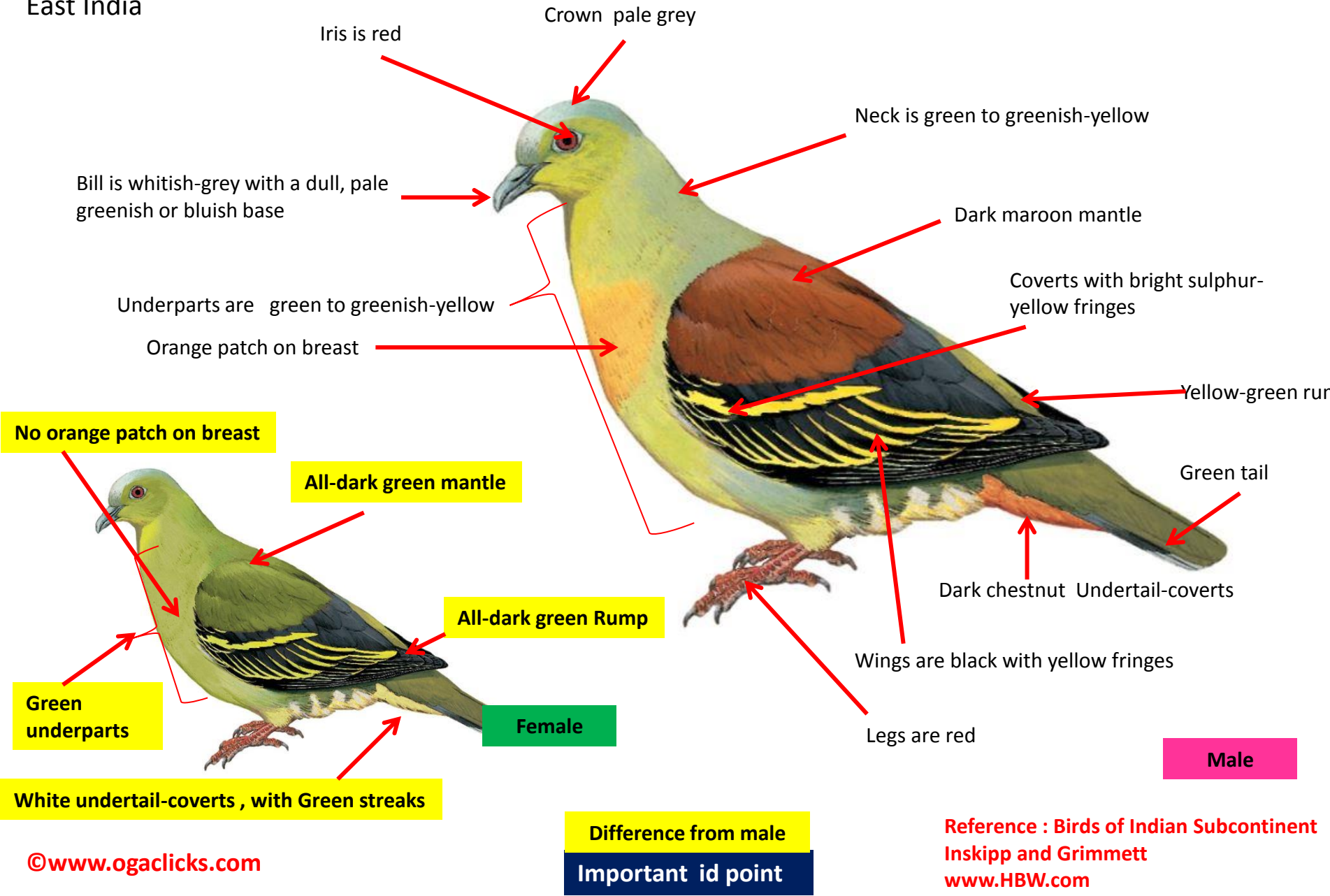

Ashy-headed Green Pigeon Identification Tips

Ashy-headed Green Pigeon : *Treron pompadora phayrei*: Resident of Himalayan foothills & North East India



Iris is red

Crown pale grey

Neck is green to greenish-yellow

Bill is whitish-grey with a dull, pale greenish or bluish base

Dark maroon mantle

Underparts are green to greenish-yellow

Coverts with bright sulphur-yellow fringes

Orange patch on breast

Yellow-green rump

No orange patch on breast

All-dark green mantle

Green tail

All-dark green Rump

Dark chestnut Undertail-coverts

Green underparts

Female

Wings are black with yellow fringes

Legs are red

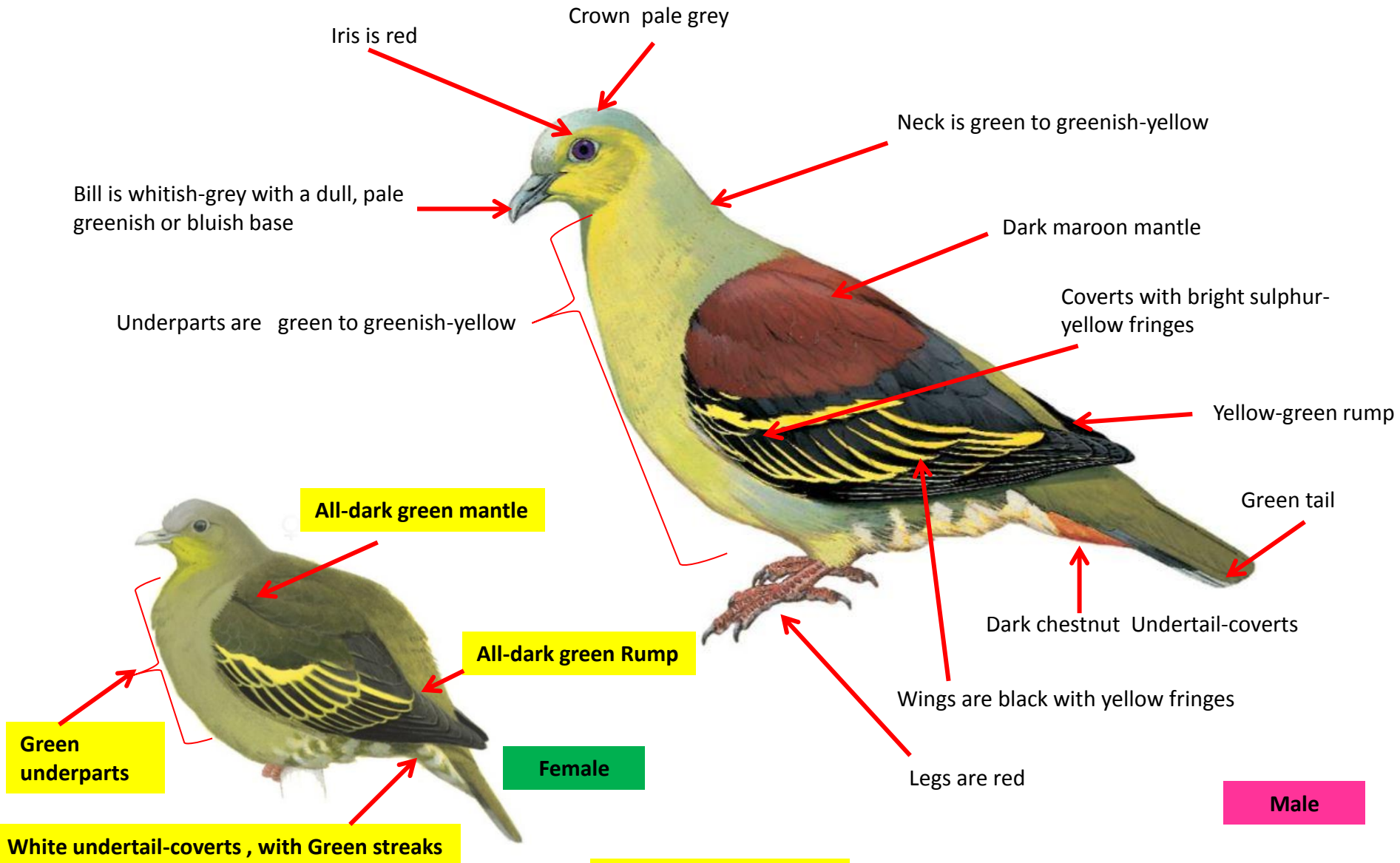

Grey-fronted Green Pigeon : *Treron pompadora affinis*: Resident of Western Ghats in India

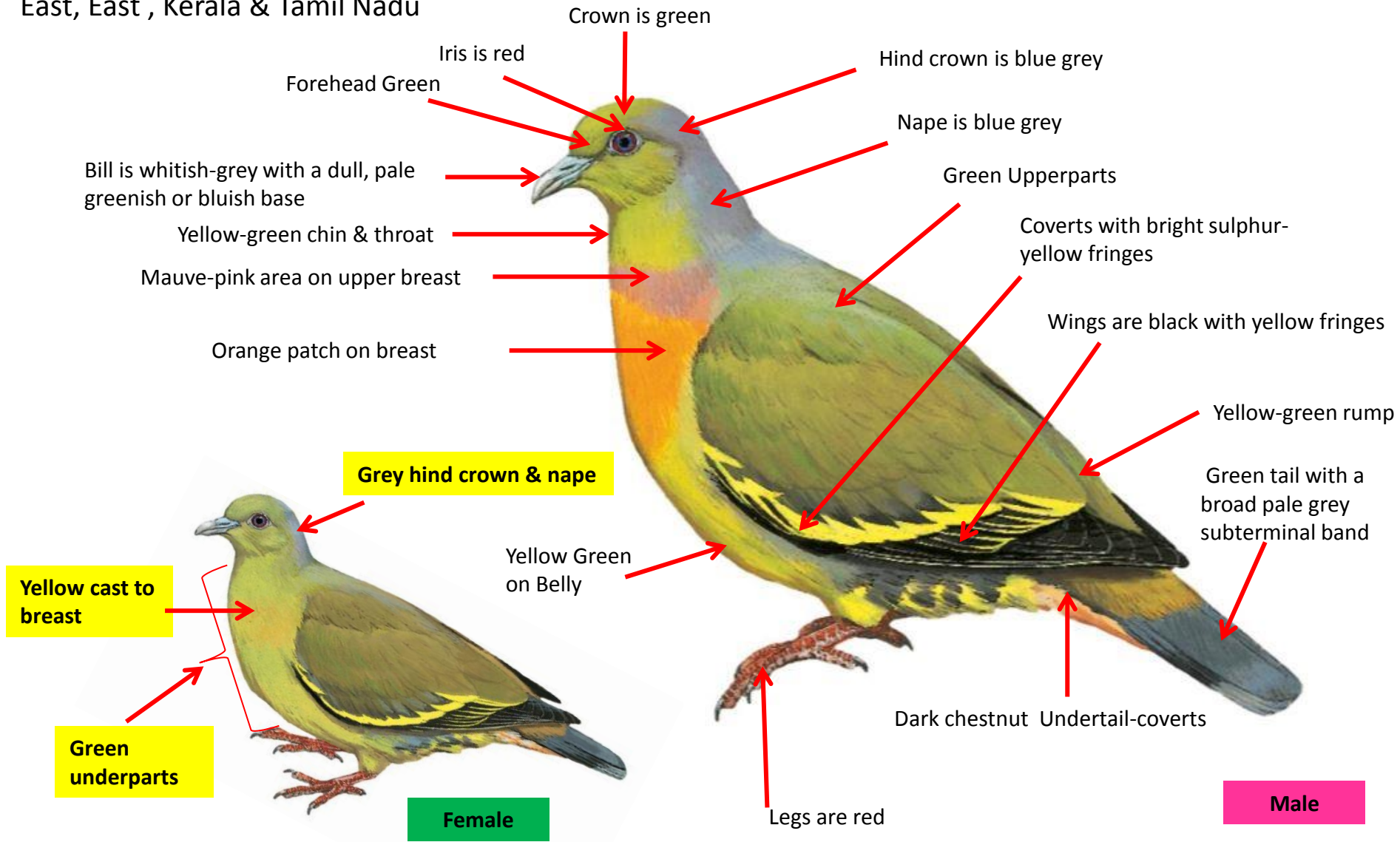

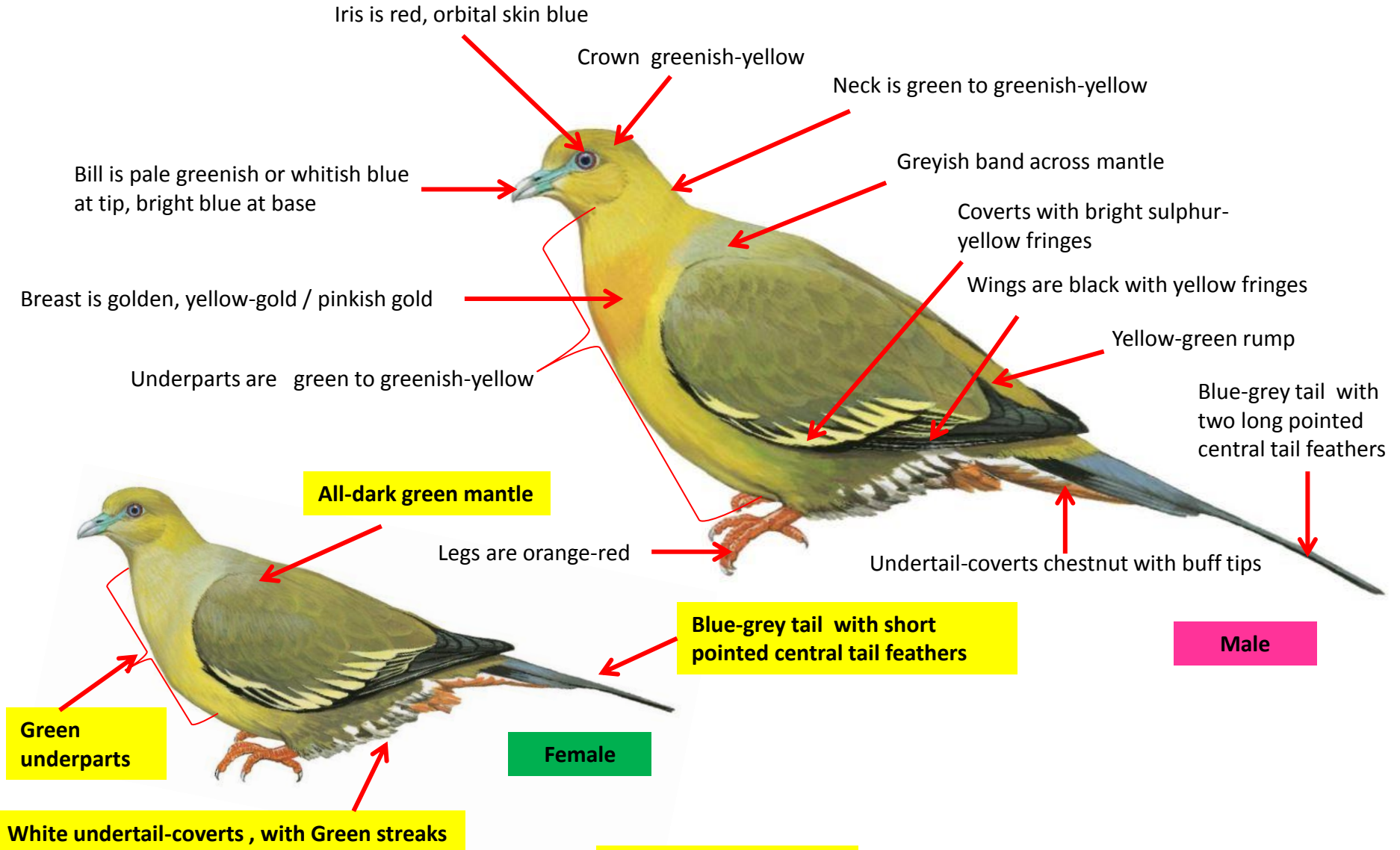

Thick Billed Green Pigeon Identification Tips

Thick Billed Green Pigeon : *Treron curvirostra* : Resident of East Himalayas & North East India

Orbital skin green/bluish green boarded with black outline

Crown & head are Blue-grey

Bill is pale green, yellowish or whitish, with red patch at side of base

Neck is green to greenish-yellow

Maroon mantle

Coverts with bright sulphur-yellow fringes

Wings are black with yellow fringes

Yellow-green rump

Green tail with a broad dark grey subterminal band

Underparts are green to greenish-yellow

Legs are orange-red

Undertail-coverts chestnut with buff tips

All olive-green mantle

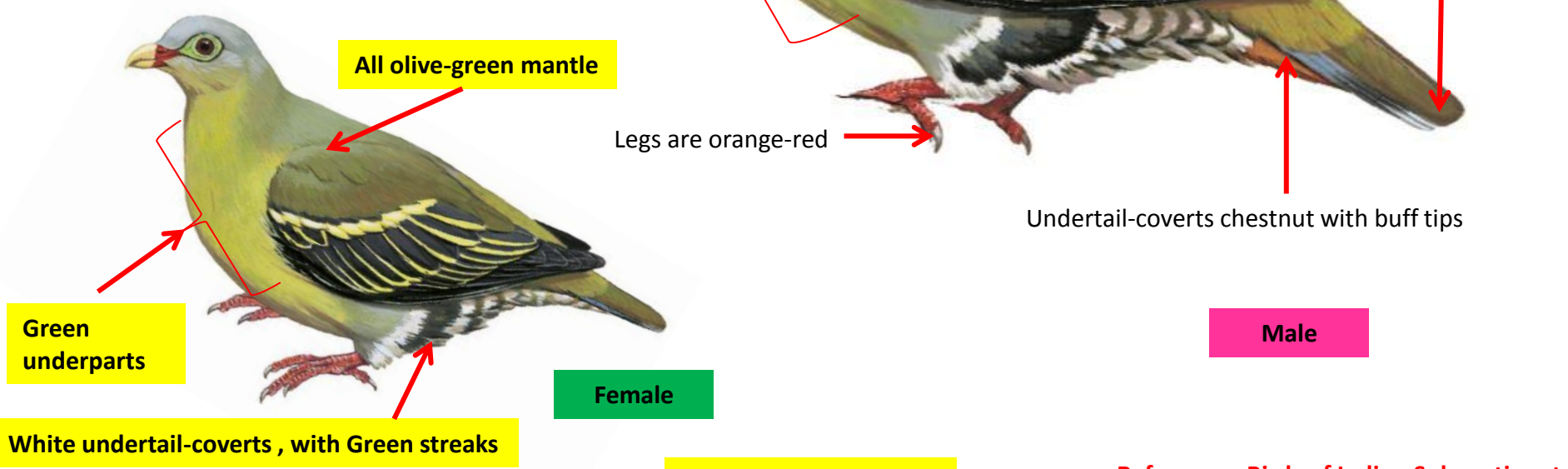

Wedge-tailed Green Pigeon Identification Tips

Wedge-tailed Green Pigeon : *Treron sphenurus*: Resident of Himalayas & North East India

Orbital skin light blue

Crown is coppery gold

Forehead is bright yellowish-green

Neck is green to greenish-yellow

Bill is light blue at base, whitish blue or greyish at tip

Vinous grey upper mantle

Breast feathers are salmon-pink, golden at tips

Dark purplish chestnut scapulars

Underparts are green to greenish-yellow

Grey-green/dark green coverts

Wings are black with yellow fringes

Crown is green

Grey green rump

All olive-green mantle

Dark Green tail bluntly wedge-shaped

Legs are Deep pink/Bright red

Undertail-coverts pale yellowish chestnut

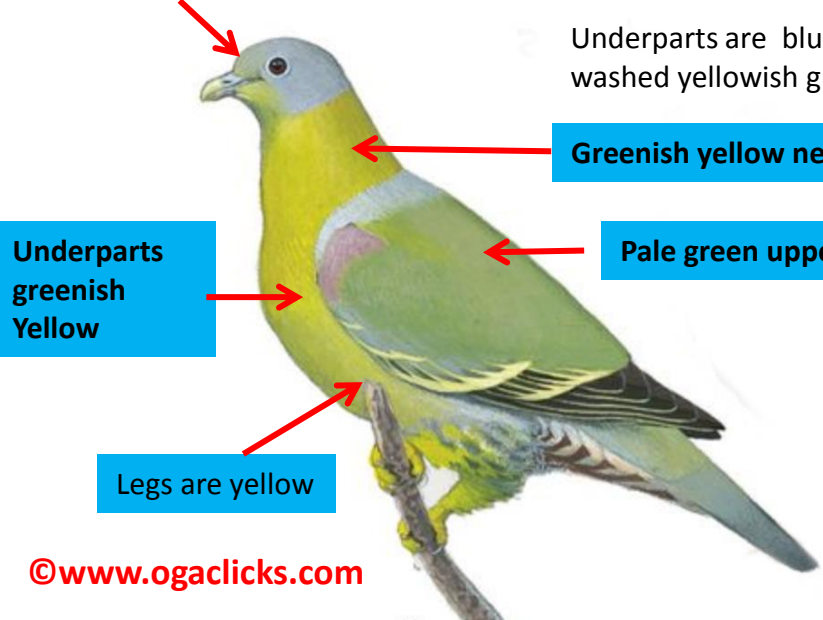
Yellow-footed Green Pigeon Identification Tips

Yellow-footed Green Pigeon : *Treron phoenicopterus*: Widespread resident in India (Except Himalayas & North West India)
