

Raptors at a glance

Raptors: Any of numerous carnivorous birds that hunt and kill other animals


Derived from Latin word *rapere*: To ravish

Characterised by Hooked Beak, Talons and Flying abilities required to hunt & kill prey



Harriers

- > Harriers have long wings, a long narrow tail, the slow and low flight
- > Harriers hunt by flying low over open ground, feeding on small mammals, reptiles, or birds
- > Harriers often Circle the grasslands in search of prey, hence the genus is called "Circus"
- > Harriers have a white band on top of their tails making it easy to Identify them against other Raptors
- > Harriers exhibit sexual dimorphism . The Male & female of a species look different from each other.







Hen Harrier: Circus cyaneus: Winter visitor to Himalayas & North India





Montagu's Harrier: Circus pygargus: Widespread Winter visitor in India




Pallid Harrier identification Tips


Dark Brown iris

3	Hen Harrier	Folded wings falls short of tail
4	Montagu's Harrier	Folded wings reaches up to tail
5	Pallid Harrier	Folded wings falls short of tail
6	Pied Harrier	Folded wings falls short of tail
