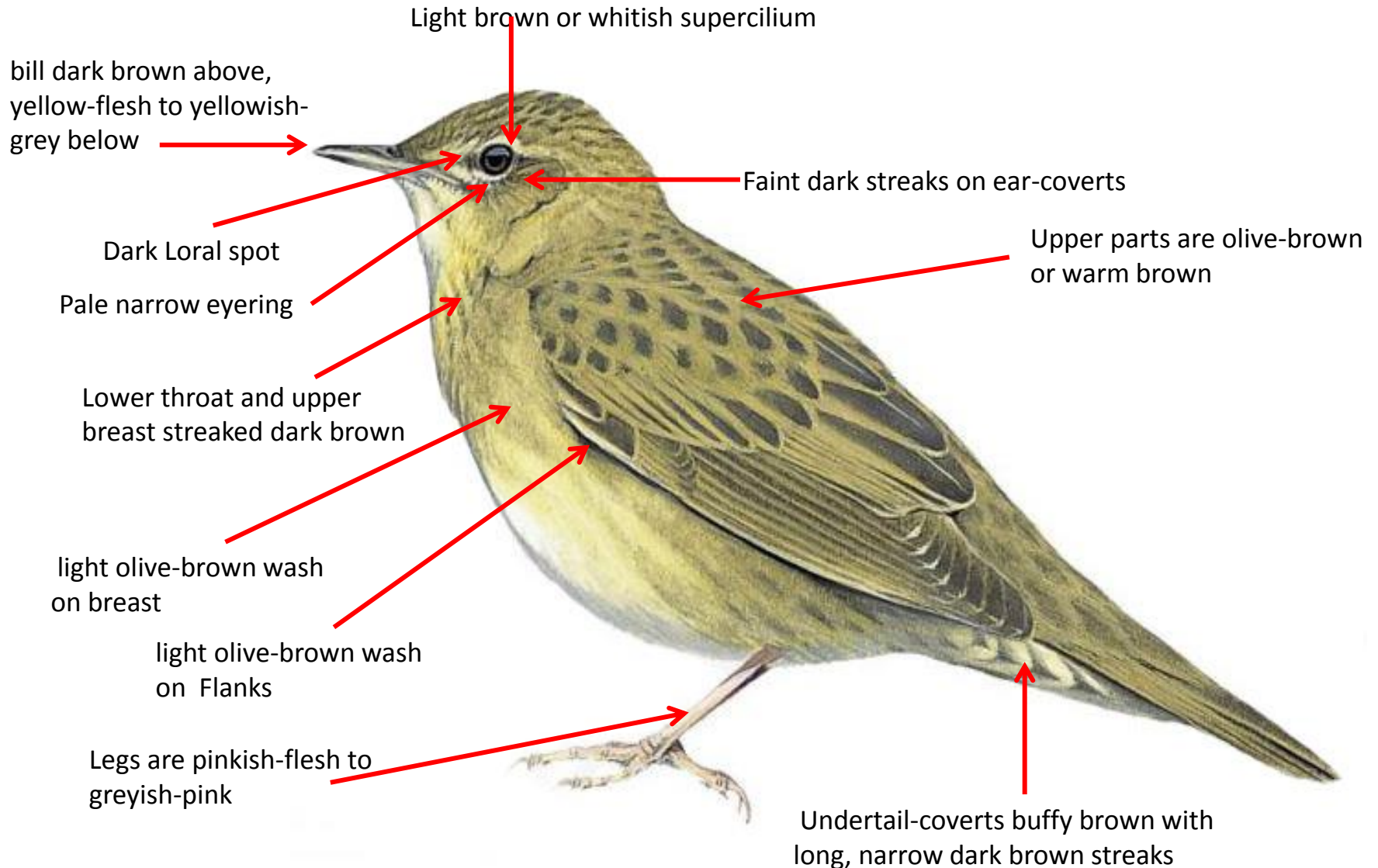

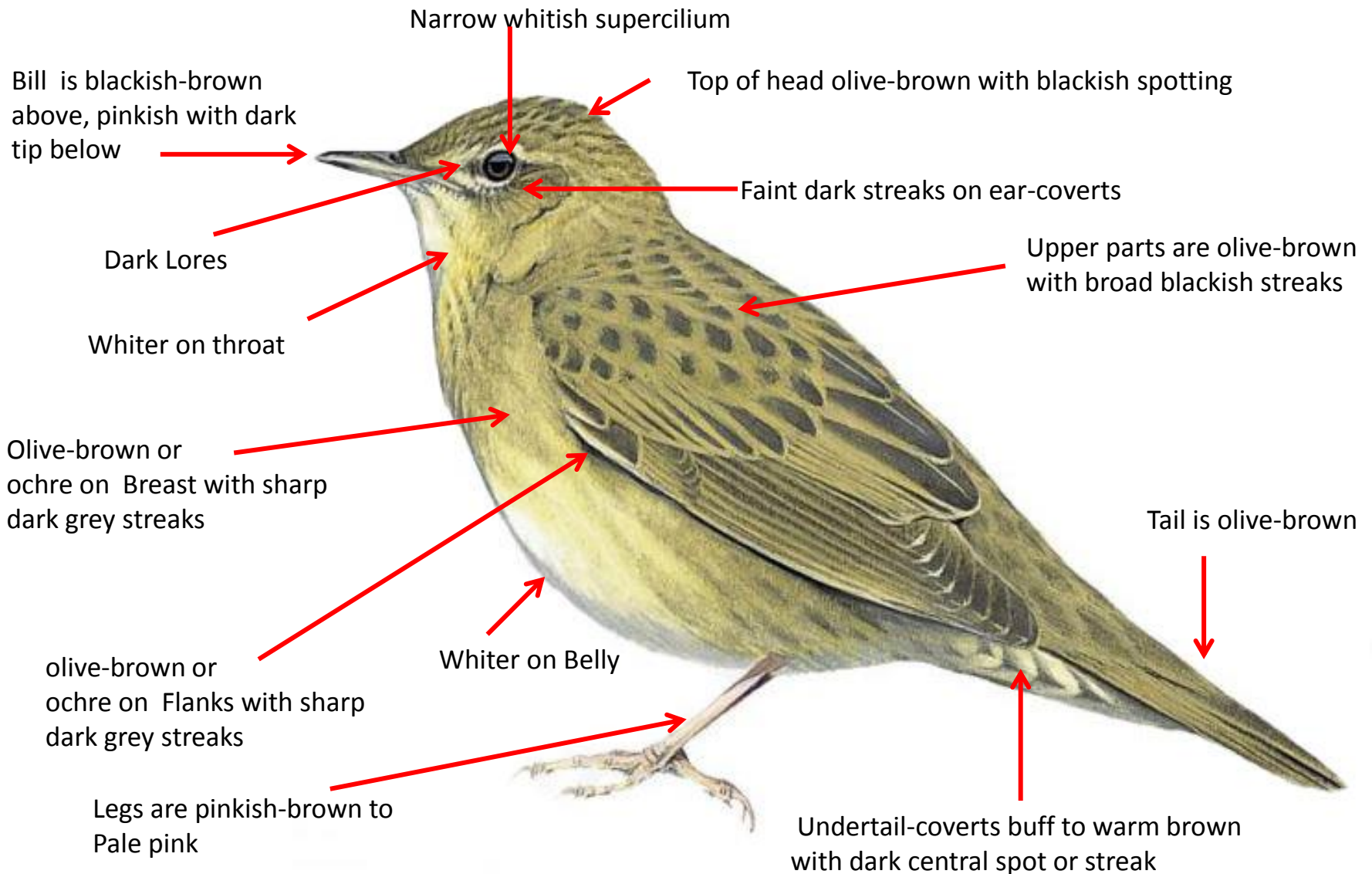
Grasshopper Warbler - Identification Tips

Syke's Warbler : *Locustella naevia straminea*: EASTERN GRASSHOPPER-WARBLER – Widespread (sporadic spread) winter visitor in India



Lanceolated Warbler - Identification Tips

Lanceolated Warbler: *Locustella lanceolata*: Winter Visitor in North East Indian Subcontinent, Andamans and Nicobars Islands



Rusty-rumped Warbler- Identification Tips

Rusty-rumped Warbler : *Locustella certhiola centralasiae* : Palla's Grasshopper Warbler- Winter Visitor to North east India

Bill is dark horn-brown or blackish above, pale yellowish or flesh-coloured with dark tip below

Prominent pale buff supercilium

Top of head with heavy black streaking

Faint dark streaks on ear-coverts

Upper parts are warm olive-brown

Rufous Rump and uppertail-coverts

Dark Lores

Whiter on throat

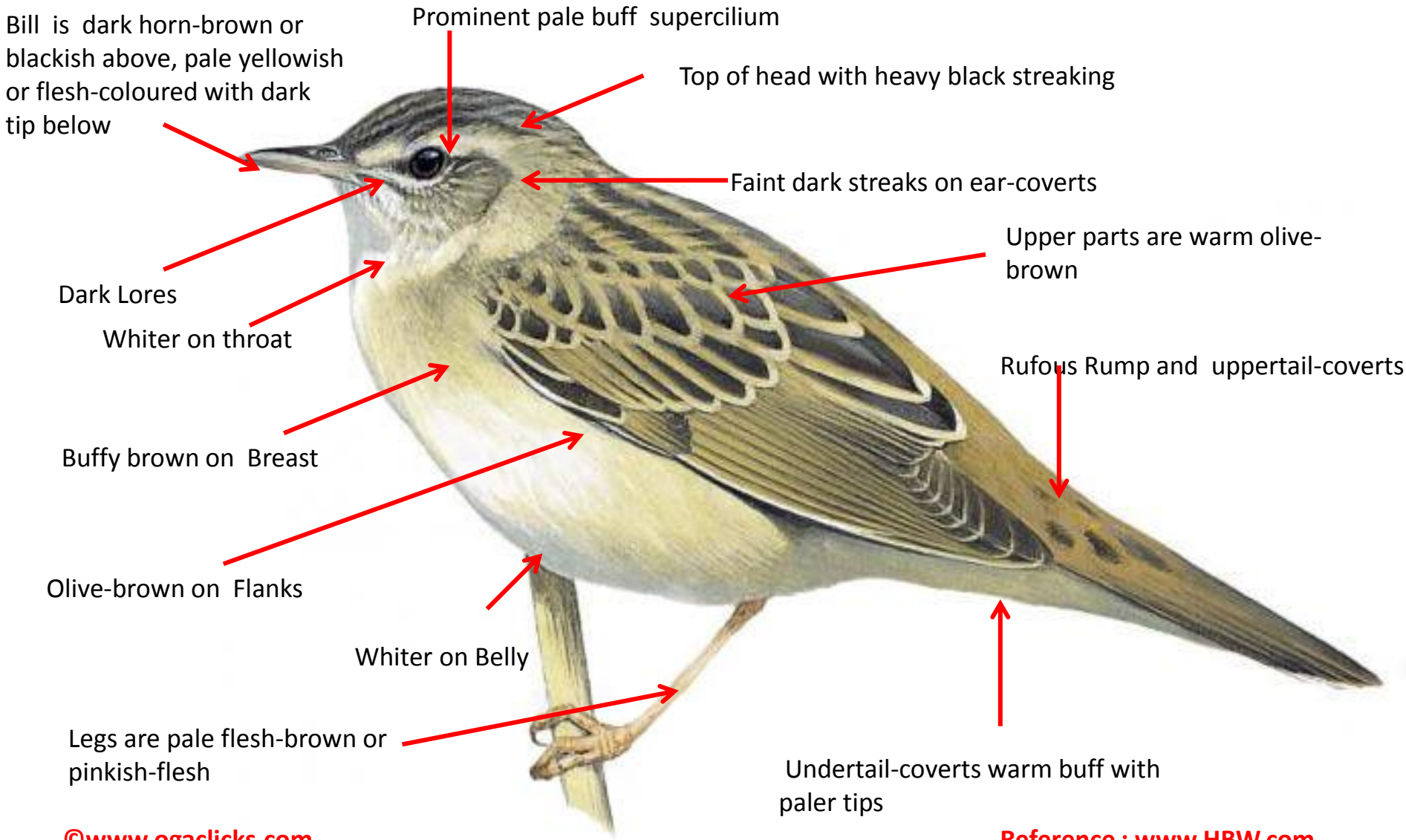
Buffy brown on Breast

Olive-brown on Flanks

Whiter on Belly

Legs are pale flesh-brown or pinkish-flesh

Undertail-coverts warm buff with paler tips

Thick-billed Warbler: *Phragamaticola aedon* : Winter Visitor to Kerala, West Tamil Nadu, North East , Andaman and Nicobar Islands
