





Asian Koel: Eudynamys scolopaceus: Widespread resident in India




#### **Banded Bay Cuckoo Identification Tips**

**Banded Bay Cuckoo**: Cacomantis sonneratii: Resident of western Ghats, West Tamilnadu, Madhya Pradesh, Odisha, Chattisgarh, Foothills of Himalayas & North East India

**Chestnut-winged Cuckoo**: Cacomantis sonneratii: Breeds in Himalayas & North East India, Winter Visitor to Tamil Nadu & Kerala in India



#### **Common Hawk Cuckoo Identification Tips**

Common Hawk Cuckoo: Hierococcyx varius: Widespread resident (except Rajasthan & UT of Jammu & Kashmir & UT of Ladhak in India ) Eye-ring pale grey, iris yellow Bill is yellowish above and greenish Ashy brownish grey crown below, black tips Ashy brownish grey Upperparts Chin & throat is White Breast is rufous Ashy brownish grey Wings Underparts are white & Barred dull rufous head barred with rufous bands Legs are yellow White nape, rufous streaks **Brown upperparts** Tail is ashy brownish grey with Black Bands (3-5)**Both the sexes Similar Underparts brown**streaked buffy-white Tail is rufous ,barred black **Immature Reference: Birds of Indian Subcontinent Difference from Adult Inskipp and Grimmett** ©www.ogaclicks.com Important id point www.HBW.com


Eurasian Cuckoo: Cuculus canorus: Breeds in Himalayas, North, Central & North East India, Scattered winter visitor in India Ashy brownish grey crown Eyering yellow, iris light brown to orange Dark Ashy brownish grey Upperparts Bill is black with yellow base Chin & throat is Ashy grey Black tail with white tips Upper breast is Ashy grey-Underparts are white & barred with black bands Legs are yellow Male Dark Ashy brownish grey Wings Rufous crown barred black **Upperparts barred chestnut and** blackish brown Female (Hepatic Morph) **Rufous & plain** uppertail covert & rump **Underparts white barred** Tail is rufous, pale chestnut and barred black, blackish tipped white **Barring starts from Breast** with a rufous wash **Rufous Wings with Black bars** & black edges **Female** Reference: Birds of Indian Subcontinent **Difference from Male Inskipp and Grimmett** ©www.ogaclicks.com


#### **Grey-bellied Cuckoo Identification Tips**


#### **Himalayan Cuckoo Identification Tips**

Himalayan Cuckoo :Cuculus saturatus: Breeds in Himalayas, & North East India, winter visitor in




## **Hodgson's Hawk Cuckoo Identification Tips**

Hodgson's Hawk Cuckoo: Hierococcyx fugax: Resident in Eastern Himalayas & hills of North east India




#### **Indian Cuckoo Identification Tips**

Indian Cuckoo: Cuculus micropterus: Breeds in East, Central, Gangetic plains; Resident of Andhra Pradesh, Tamilnadu, Kerala & Andaman & Nicobar Islands

#### **Large Hawk Cuckoo Identification Tips**

Large Hawk Cuckoo: Hierococcyx sparverioides: Breeds in Himalayas & North East India, Scattered winter visitor in India Eyering yellow, iris tawny-yellow to orange Ashy grey crown Bill is blackish above and greenish slate below Ashy grey nape Chin & throat is White, grey-streaked White moustache and supraloral area Breast is rusty with blackish stripe **Brown Upperparts** Underparts are white with black barring Legs are yellow **Brownish grey Wings** Nape pale rufous streaked dark **Both the sexes Similar** Upperparts are dull dark brown barred rufous-brown Tail is barred brownish Underparts are white with grey and black, tipped boldly streaked black with white chevron-like bars **Immature** Reference: Birds of Indian Subcontinent **Difference from Adult Inskipp and Grimmett**



## **Lesser Cuckoo Identification Tips**

Lesser Cuckoo: Cuculus poliocephalus: Breeds in Himalayas, & North East India, Passage migrant in peninsular India Ashy grey crown Eyering yellow, iris brown to yellow Slate grey Upperparts Bill is black with yellow base Dark Ashy brownish grey Wings Chin & throat is light grey Tail is blackish with white tip and white spots at sides Breast is light grey Underparts are white & barred with black bands Male Legs are yellow to orange Rufous crown barred black Rufous Upperparts barred rufous and black Rufous uppertail covert & rump (plain) White Throat & breast barred black Tail is rufous, barred black, tipped white **Underparts white barred black Breast with a rufous wash Rufous Wings with Black bars** & black edges **Female** Female (Hepatic Morph) **Reference: Birds of Indian Subcontinent Difference from Male Inskipp and Grimmett** ©www.ogaclicks.com Important id point www.HBW.com



# Hawk cuckoo's Comparison- Adult


#### **Common Hawk Cuckoo**

Breast is rufous

Underparts are white & barred with rufous bands

Tail is ashy brownish grey with Black Bands (3-5)



Chin & throat is White, greystreaked


Breast is rusty with blackish stripe

#### **Common Hawk Cuckoo**

Underparts brownstreaked buffy-white

#### Hodgson's Hawk Cuckoo



Underparts are white with rufous-edged dark brown spots or streaks

Dark grey upperparts barred rufous

Tail is barred brownish grey and black, tipped white

Barred dull rufous head

Tail is rufous, barred black

Nape pale rufous streaked dark

Underparts are white with boldly streaked black with chevron-like bars
