

#### Indian Robin : Copsychus fulicatus :


Nominate-South India

- C. f. intermedius Central India (River Tapti, South Madhya Pradesh and Odisha South to River Krishna)







Firethroat: Luscinia pectardens: Recorded in East & North East India (West Bengal, Meghalaya, North



















White-browed Bush -robin : Tarsiger indicus : Resident of Himalayas & hills of North East India




#### **Bluetails Comparison-Male**




Blue supercilium

White supercilium that becomes blue behind the eye








