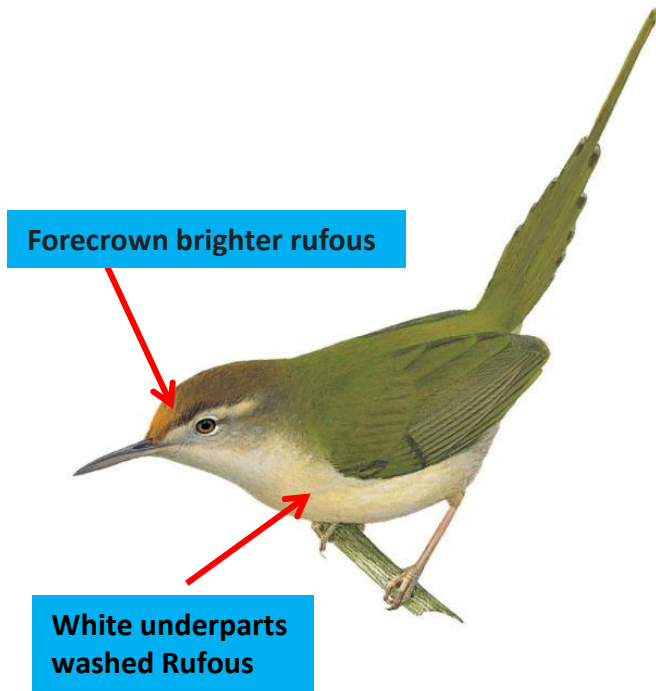

3	Mountain tailorbird	<i>Phyllergates cucullatus coronatus</i>

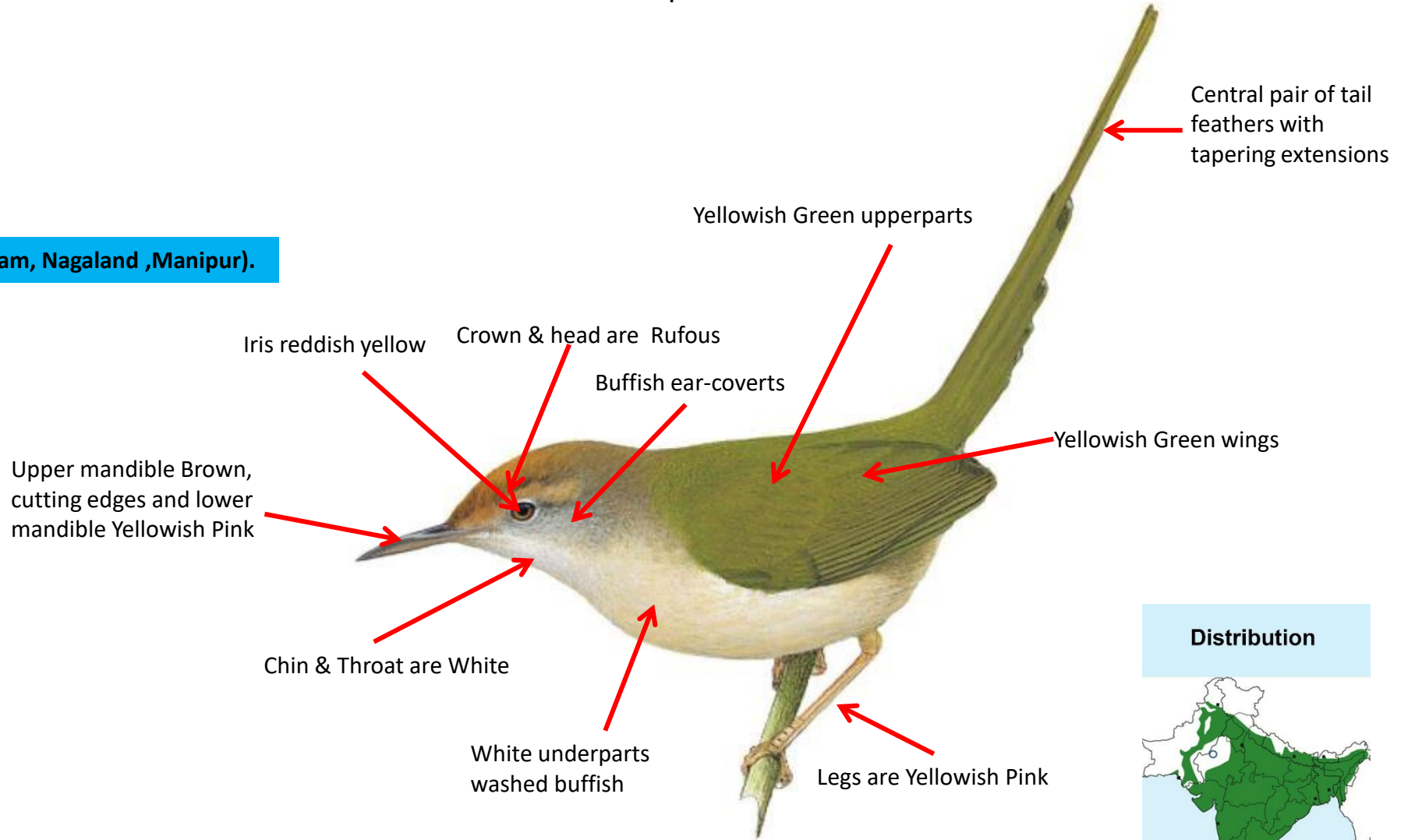
Common Tailorbird identification Tips

O. s. luteus- Resident of North East India (East Assam, Nagaland , Manipur).

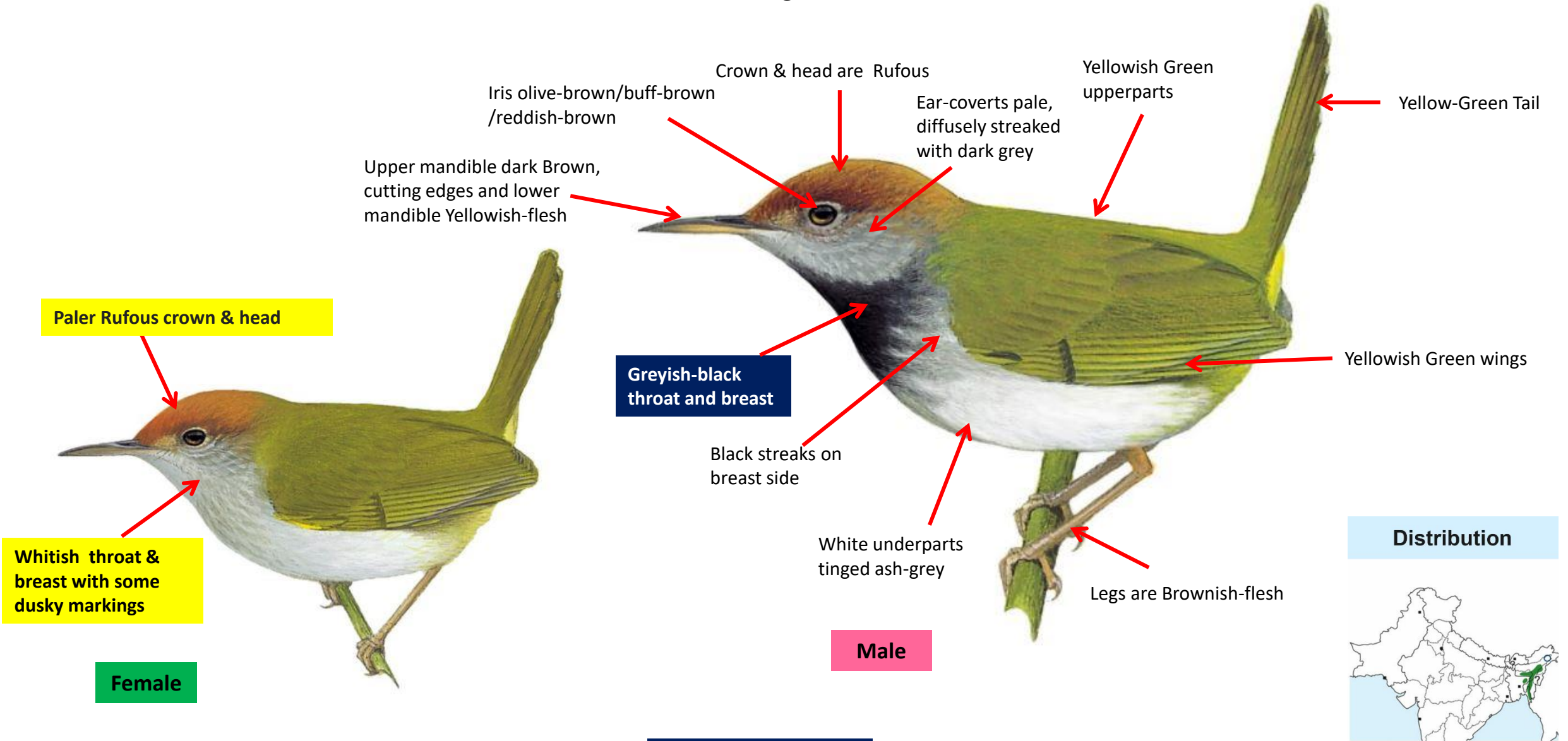

Dark-necked Tailorbird identification Tips - *O. a. nitidus*

Dark-necked Tailorbird : *Orthotomus atrogularis nitidus* : Resident of North East India



Iris olive-brown/buff-brown /reddish-brown

Crown & head are Rufous

Yellowish Green upperparts

Yellow-Green Tail

Ear-coverts pale, diffusely streaked with dark grey

Upper mandible dark Brown, cutting edges and lower mandible Yellowish-flesh

Paler Rufous crown & head

Yellowish Green wings

Greyish-black throat and breast

Black streaks on breast side

White underparts tinged ash-grey

Legs are Brownish-flesh

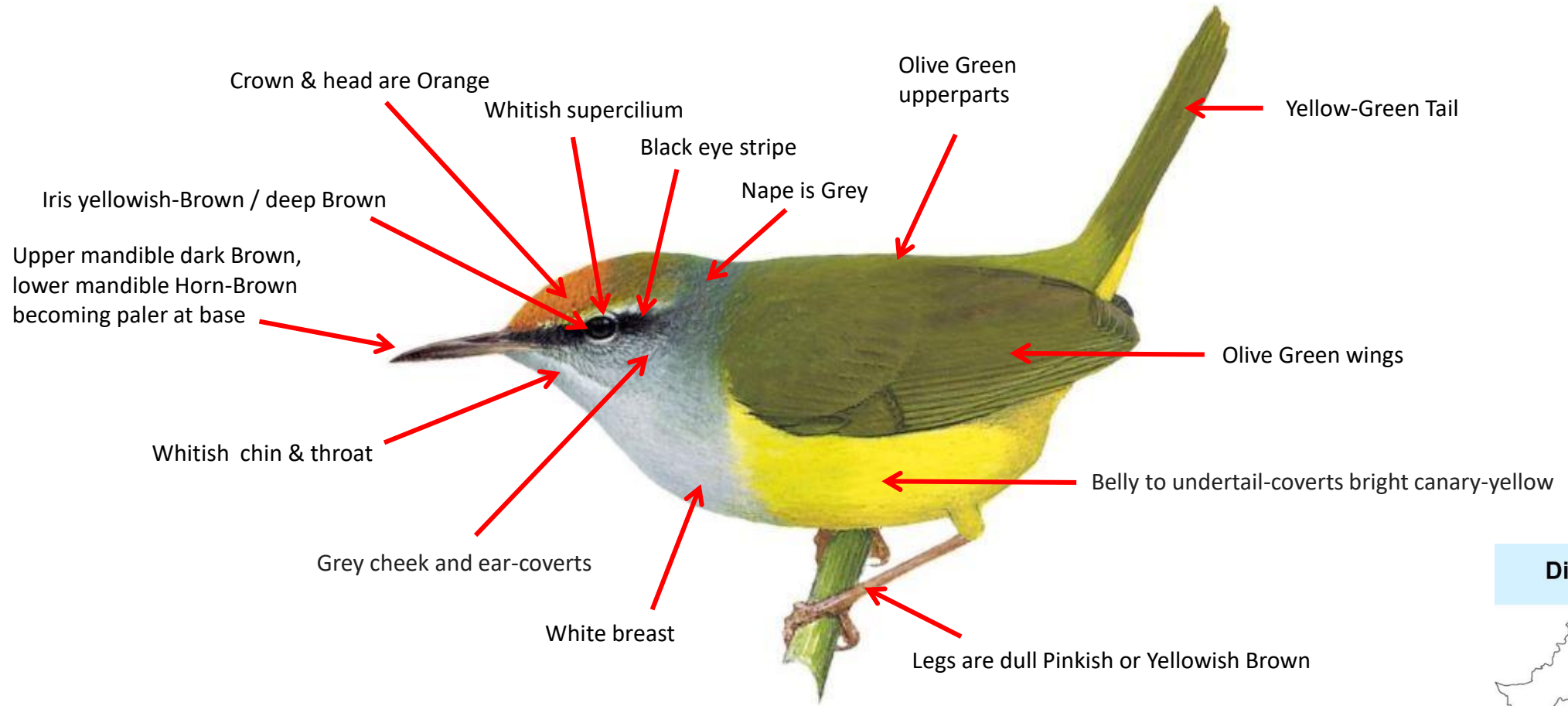
